They learned to greet prospects, overcome objections and close the sale with a smile. The boys' winning ways earned them the top award! Years later, she still incorporates training with clients as well as with students, as an adjunct professor at universities including San Diego State University and Pacific College of Health and Science.

The combination of her journalism, psychology and communication training from Pepperdine University and California State University Northridge enabled Shahrzad to unearth and articulate exactly what people wanted to know, learn and practice. In her role as a public relations professional for the Los Angeles City Recreation and Parks Department, she created knowledge about diverse City employees and programs at the Los Angeles Zoo, Griffith Park Observatory and parks across Los Angeles County.

As a consultant for *Mercer HR Consulting*, she aided employees in companies such as Disney and Nestle in understanding their company's vision, values, performance goals and benefits.

She later implemented an interactive talent management program at *Valley Crest Companies* that led to a 95% retention rate and over 80 employees getting promoted.

In 2008, when Shahrzad faced a dangerous intersection in her neighborhood with no safe pedestrian crossing available through five lanes of traffic, she knew she had to drive and implement her own coaching mantra of perseverance. Cultivating collaboration with neighbors, city council members and the community, she led her community in obtaining safety in the form of a pedestrian-activated crosswalk. This grand effort earned her accolades including Citizen of the Year by *Circulate San Diego*, Trailblazer of the Year by *NAWBO* (National Association of Women Business Owners) and Voice to Listen to by the *La Jolla Light* newspaper.

Diversity and Inclusion Connecting to our Humanity

As a first-generation American, Shahrzad understands the gifts and challenges of straddling two cultures as well as the immigrant experience by watching her parents live the American success story. They went from learning English and working as factory workers at Brach's Candy Company to becoming business owners who made a difference in their communities. She speaks four languages conversationally and is obsessed by international travel.

Her non-profit work includes supporting *Room to Read*, an organization that builds schools and libraries in developing countries and *Just in Time*, an organization that supports foster youth in transition. Her talks on Diversity Equity and Inclusion (DEI) create awareness of unconscious bias and new ways of showing up to embrace and include the many ways we are diverse in the workplace.
